

Names of the deceased	Dj-Osiris and family(?)
Construction material	Local limestone
Number of burials	Shaft in the 2nd room: 2 limestone sarcophagi with a plaster mask (Cairo, Egyptian Museum JE 58445) and ushebtis with the inscription "Dj-Osiris, the Great of the Five"; 2 nd room: 5 limestone sarcophagi, one of them belonged to a child
Number of floors	1
Number of rooms	2 plus small room with two floors north of the 1 st room

Decoration	Egyptian façade with torus and cavetto, frame of the door with torus and cavetto
