


Date of construction	3 rd century AD (together with GB 7 on the right)
Names of the deceased	Prometheus (charioteer); Harsiese(?)
Construction material	Mudbrick
Number of burials	Unknown (buried in a shaft at the back of the second room)
Number of floors	3 (ground floor: not excavated, second floor: stairway leading to the roof of the first floor)

GB 6 (M 22/SS)

Number of rooms	2 with front hall
Number of niches	2 in the first room
Decoration	Imitation of <i>opus sectile</i> in the front hall and the first room
Inscriptions	Graffiti on the northern wall of the front hall (above two horses): Ματήν, Προμηθεῦ, ἐνατὸν ἀπολέσας γένος „Vergeblich, Prometheus, hast du die enetische (Pferde)rasse vernichtet (= besiegt).“ Demotic graffito on the western wall of the 1st room: Harsiese
