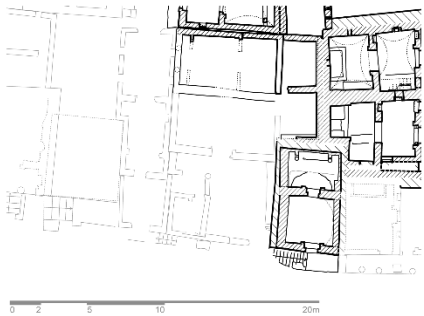


# GB 4 (M 12/SS)



<b>Date of construction</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> (1 <sup>st</sup> floor) and 2 <sup>nd</sup> century AD (2 <sup>nd</sup> floor)

<b>Number of burials</b>	1 main burial place with funerary bed on each floor

## GB 4 (M 12/SS)

<b>Decoration</b>	<p>1<sup>st</sup> floor, 1<sup>st</sup> room: ornamental vine branches; 2<sup>nd</sup> room: funeral bed with painted slabs, above it a painted shell, garlands and fruits (two layers). 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 1<sup>st</sup> room: orthostates with painted slabs, above white rectangular decoration surrounded by red and black lines; 2<sup>nd</sup> room: funeral bed in red.</p>
