


Decoration	West room: west, north, and east wall: painted imitations of horizontal (bottom) and vertical alabaster and red porphyry(?) slabs (above), borderline of wall and roof: thick red line with yellow dashes (garland?) (below), contorted red and green band (above); alcove: horizontal slabs of alabaster bordered by red lines; south wall: imitation of porphyry slabs (bottom), opus sectile (above); east room not decorated
